The Guy Mytty Wrestling Center construction is underway. The Tekamah Herman Youth Wrestling Club has started raising funds to build the center. We have even secured a piece of property just southwest of the school. The old house has been demolished and the lot has been cleared to make way for the future structure. We plan for a 5,000 square foot facility to house two practice mats, the club office, restrooms, and some storage for the club.

Our intent is to provide a place where the club wrestlers can call their own. It will be held by the club separate from the school. This gives us the ability to practice when the school facilities are otherwise occupied (i.e.: basketball games, concerts, etc.)

The wrestling club board members have taken steps to ensure the future of the Tekamah-Herman Youth Wrestling Club. This next step will be the one that continues us down the road to rebuilding the tradition that was once a staple of a storied program built by the late Coach Mytty and the hard-working wrestlers that surrounded him. This facility will not only honor Coach and his legacy, but it will provide a home for those committed to extending the reach of his work ethic.

Dear Applicant:

We're pleased to tell you we determined you're exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code (IRC) Section 501(c)(3). You formed August 1, 2014, and filed your Form 1023-EZ, Streamlined Application for Recognition of Exemption Under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, on October 11, 2017. You failed to file a required annual return or notice (Form 990, Form 990-EZ, Form 990-PF, or Form 990-N) for three consecutive years after you formed and while your application was pending. As a result, your tax-exempt status was automatically revoked on October 15, 2017, the due date of your third year return or notice. We're treating your Form 1023-EZ as an application for reinstatement and are recognizing your exemption as reinstated on the same day it was automatically revoked. As a result, you are recognized as tax exempt continuously from the effective date of exemption as listed at the top of this letter.

You're required to file Form 990-PF, Return of Private Foundation or Section 4947(a)(1) Trust Treated as Private Foundation, annually, whether or not you have income or activity during the year. If you don't file a required return

or notice for three consecutive years, your exempt status will be automatically revoked.

ADDENDUM

If you have been in existence for at least three years and you have not filed a Form 990 return or notice for three consecutive years, you may soon receive a letter (Notice CP120A) that we automatically revoked your exempt status, as required by law, for failure to file a return or notice for three consecutive years. This letter will serve to reinstate your exempt status, so you will not need to re-apply. However, you may need to file the appropriate delinquent Forms 990 for all years you have operated as a tax-exempt organization.
